The master classes are for young pianists age appr. 14 - 24 years, who want to work seriously with the piano , to improve their skills and to get inspiration by the confrontation with international teachers on a high level..

The teachers are three outstanding international pianists and professors:

The performing participants will have individual lessons in open class, opportunity to listen to other lessons, time for practising, ensemble playing, concerts as well as a musical and friendly getting together in this beautiful place in Denmark.

Non-performing participants of all ages, music lovers, teachers, students can attend the classes as well as concerts and all other arrangements including 2-4-8 hand piano, musical understanding, lectures and dancing.

The master classes will take place in Ollerup Efterskole Song & Music, beautifully situated in Ollerup Fyn about 2½ hour from Copenhagen. The school has a nice concert hall and well equipped class-rooms as well as rooms for practising. All bedrooms have a private bath.
